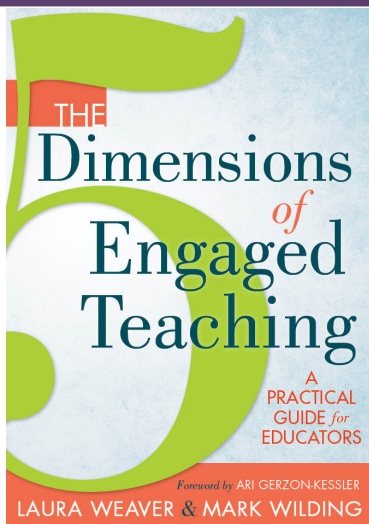


# Transformational Leadership for Educators

Transformational leadership starts from the inside out, and shows up throughout the day in all the leader's interactions with staff, students, families, community members and district personnel. These interactions are infused with personal values, social and emotional intelligence, cultural responsiveness, and an understanding of interconnectedness. This approach to leadership:

- Emphasizes the importance of every relationship;
- Builds trust with stakeholders through sincerity, competence, and reliability;
- Addresses conflict with clarity and compassion;
- Balances empathy and decisiveness;
- Creates emotionally rich and academically rigorous classrooms;
- Develops the whole teacher and the whole student across a variety of cultural backgrounds;
- Cultivates alliances across differences; and
- Honors every person.
